
With this visa, you can:

- stay in Australia permanently
- work, study and live anywhere in Australia
- enrol in Australia's free, world-class, public health care scheme
- sponsor eligible relatives for permanent residence
- if eligible, become an Australian citizen

You must:

- have an occupation on the relevant skilled occupation list
- satisfy the points test with a score of 65 points or more
- have a suitable skills assessment for the occupation











Step 1 **Skilled Occupation List**



Confirm that your occupation is on the current Australian
 Skilled Shortage List as shown in 'Step 1 of the Member's Area'.
 If 'YES', then proceed to 'Step 2 – Maximise Your Points'.







Step 2 Maximise Your Points



 Watch the video in '<u>Step 2 of the Member's Area</u>' and confirm that you have maximised the amount of points that you are eligible for and have explored the various options mentioned.

*Please note that the minimum requirement is a score of 65 points, however the higher your score the better.

If 'YES', then proceed to 'Step 3 – English Level Preparation'.








Step 3 English Level Preparation



 Confirm that you have utilised *IELTS Express* to prepare you with the skills and knowledge required to succeed in maximising your English language test result as provided in '<u>Step 3 of the Member's Area</u>'

If 'YES', then proceed to 'Step 4 – Application Guide'.








Step 4 **Application Guide**




